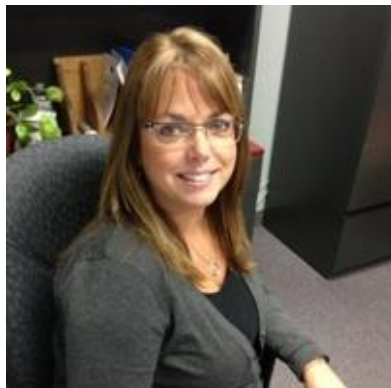
As the future of the DSAP unfolds, we continue to look for the involvement, input and feedback of our members. Please be sure to be a part of your Association.
